## 5. NON - FINANCIAL

- 5.1. This understanding does not and will not involve any financial transaction in any manner and extent whatsoever, either on part of the incumbent colleges and/or any participating faculty members.
- 5.2. Any unavoidable expense to be incurred in attaining the objective of this understanding shall be the exclusive liability of the particular incumbent college and will not be billed to and/or realized and/or recovered by it from the other incumbent college.

### 6. TERMINATION

- 6.1. This understanding can only be terminated in writing with the mutual consent of both the incumbent colleges.
- 6.2. Oral and/or implied termination will neither be effected, nor alleged at any point of time by any of the incumbent college under any circumstances whatsoever.

#### 7. ARBITRATION

- 7.1. In case of any dispute concerning this understanding, the same shall be tried to be resolved in Mediation through the respective representatives of this understanding or any person nominated by them, in their joint mediation.
- 7.2 All disputes and differences arising out of this understanding, if not settled in Mediation as aforesaid in terms of sub-clause (7.1) of this clause, shall be resolved in Arbitration before a sole Arbitrator to be jointly nominated by the parties herein to that effect upon mutual discussion and in terms of the provisions of THE ARBITRATION AND CONCILIATION ACT, 1996 (As Amended till Date). The proceedings before the Arbitrator shall be in English.
- 7.3. The sole Arbitrator to be nominated by the parties under this agreement shall be an Indian national and a qualified working/retired professor/assistant professor of B. Voc. of any college (other than the incumbent colleges) affiliated to any state/national university having his place of residence in the city of Kolkata. Persons having previous experience of adjudication of disputes arising under similar agreements shall be given preference while selecting an Arbitrator.
- 7.4. The laws of India shall be followed while adjudicating the disputes under this understanding.
- 7.5. The venue of the Arbitration shall be within the limits of the city of Kolkata.
- 7.6. The parties hereby choose the jurisdiction of the City Civil Court, Kolkata, for all legal purpose.
